

# Drain And Refill Transmission Fluid

**Drain And Refill Transmission Fluid** - 1. Remove drain plug from CVT oil pan. 2. Drain fluid 3. Reinstall drain plug in oil pan 4. Fill CVT with tranny fluid at the charging pipe 5. Drive CVT for 10 min 6. Check fluid level. 7. Add fluid if necessary. Now on the actual procedure. Remember to only use OEM Nissan Fluid. Specs below: CVT AUTO Type: NISSAN CVT Transmission Fluid Part ...What you described is the "proper way" to do a drain and fill on a 1996 automatic cavalier. Remove bolts to transmission pan. Drop pan and remove fluid. Remove old trans filter and replace with new trans filter. Reinstall transmission pan with a new gasket. Fill transmission with Dextron III transmission fluid. Transmission flush vs. transmission fluid drain and refill... Has anyone here done a transmission flush yet? I know some vehicles can be sensitive to a flush vs. just draining and filling it. My main concern would be damage to the solenoids and/or other things that can't handle the pressure.
